CONFERENCE PARTICIPATION AWARDS FOR GRADUATE STUDENTS AND POSTDOCTORAL SCHOLARS (2016)

The Society for Mathematical Psychology is providing a limited number of conference participation awards in the range of \$50-\$150 on a competitive basis. The purpose of these student conference participation awards is to subsidize the costs of travel to the Society for Mathematical Psychology Meeting (www.mathpsych.org). In order to be eligible for a graduate student or postdoctoral scholar conference participation award, an award applicant must satisfy the following conditions:

- (1) Be a student member or member of the Society for Mathematical Psychology (application forms may be found at: www.mathpsych.org)
- (2) Be a co-author on an abstract for an oral or poster presentation at the Society for Mathematical Psychology Meeting.
- (3) Submit a copy of the abstract as part of the student award application file.
- (4) Submit an updated academic vita summarizing professional accomplishments.

Please submit your application materials which consist of a copy of the submitted abstract and an updated vita via EMAIL using the email address: mathpsych@aol.com with subject header: *2016 Student Award* <nominee name>.

The application materials must be received by the Secretary-Treasurer, Richard M. Golden, before April 15, 2016.

Awards will be officially announced and distributed in person at the next meeting of the Society for Mathematical Psychology at the Business Meeting.
