R. Duncan Luce Outstanding Paper Award (2019)

The Society for Mathematical Psychology presents an award annually for the most outstanding paper published in the *Journal of Mathematical Psychology* in the preceding three years. The award is named after R. Duncan Luce, recognizing his founding role in the field of mathematical psychology, and in our Society and the journal.

For the 2019 award, publications dated 2016 - 2019 will be considered.

Nominations should include exact title, authors, and publication date in the *Journal of Mathematical Psychology*.

The authors nominated need not be members of the Society.

Self-nominations will not be considered.

The winner will be selected by a special committee appointed by the Executive Committee and in consultation with the Editor of the *Journal of Mathematical Psychology*. The winner will be announced at the 52nd Annual Mathematical Psychology Society Meeting in 2019.
